



## 2023 Dolores L. Peck Art Scholarship Guidelines

- The scholarship is open to all high school students in St. Joseph County, Elkhart County, and all adjacent counties.
- Two winners will receive an award of \$500 each.
- This year's contest is open to visual art media (photography, painting, sculpture, collage, storyboard, digital graphic, textile art, etc.) and performance art.
- Work must be submitted to the Right to Life Michiana Office. Digital graphic can be submitted as a .JPEG/.PNG file while performance art recordings can be submitted as an .MP4/.WAV file. Email submissions to [events@prolifemichiana.org](mailto:events@prolifemichiana.org).
- Along with the submission of the original piece, an artist statement (no more than 250 words) is required explaining and interpreting the piece.
- Only one entry per student will be accepted, and any submissions that are found to not be originals will be automatically disqualified.
- Entries must be received or postmarked by May 31st.
- Winners will be notified by June 14th.
- Right to Life Michiana, Inc. reserves the right to publish and/or publicly read all or any portion of entries received. All entries will be returned after the scholarship winners are chosen.
